**Directions:**  
PTH 59 South to 3 miles North of  
St-Pierre-Jolys; west of PTH 303

**Length:** 3 miles or 4.9 kms

**Description:**  
Follow trail on College grounds; go  
west into Otterburne, then back to  
Access Point.

**History:**  
\*In 1912 the Clercs de St-Viateur  
established an orphanage for boys. In  
1957, it was turned into a secondary  
school. In 1970, the Winnipeg Bible  
College took it over. Today, enrolment =  
800 students from all over the world.  
\*\*Otterburne was once a bustling  
community on the CPR line. The railway  
caused the demise of the Crow Wing Trail by  
1870.
