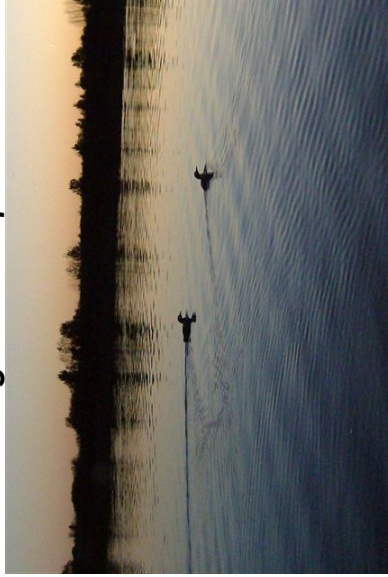


## **ABOUT RSTA**

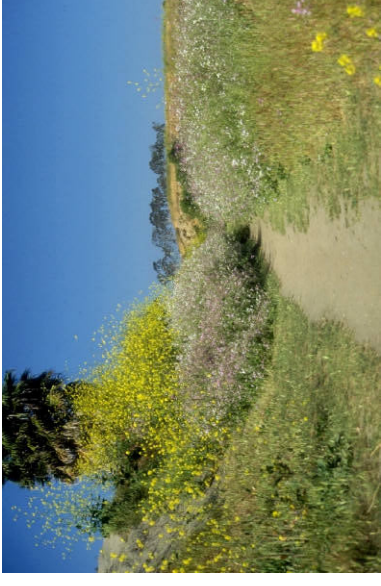
