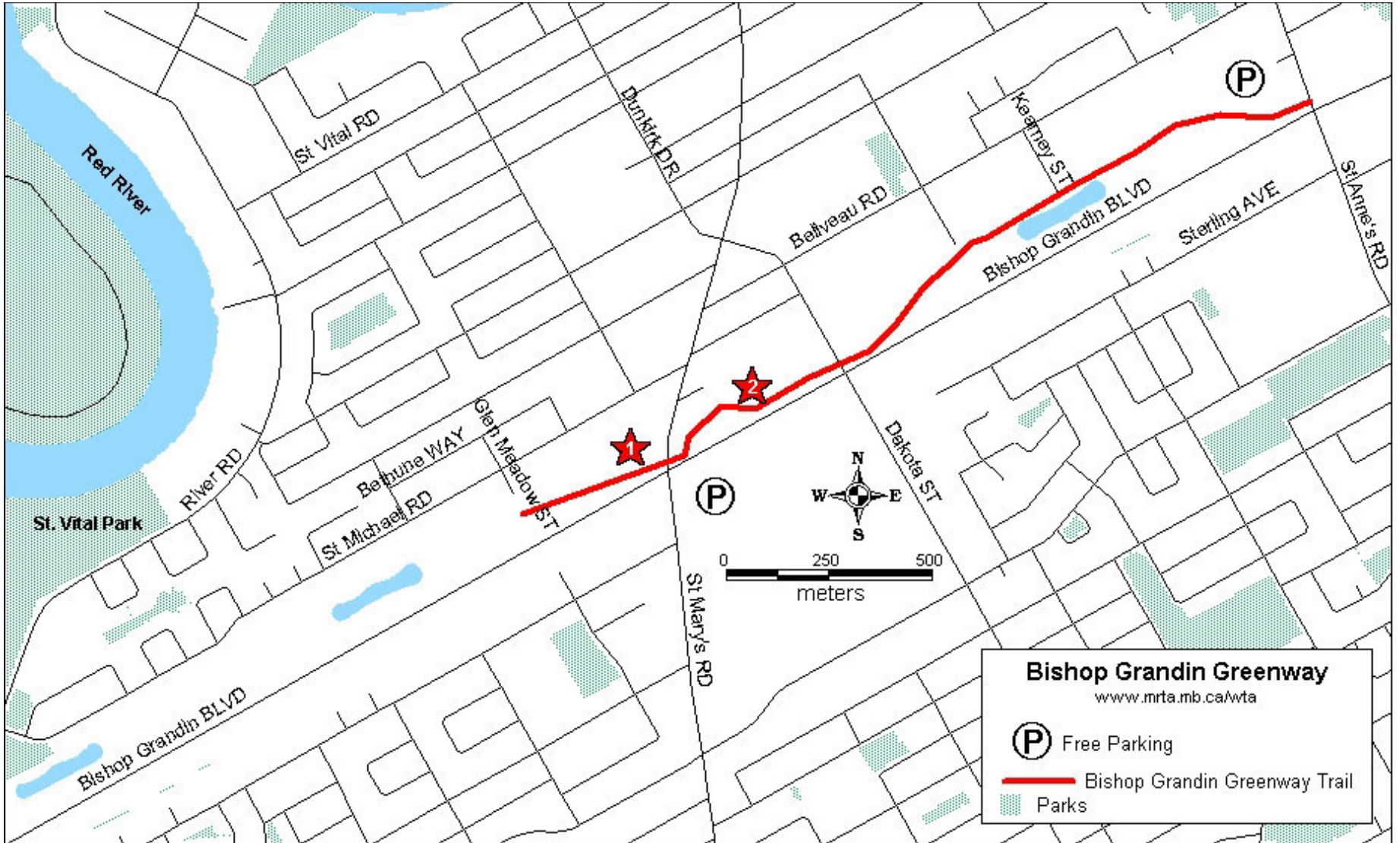

Bishop Grandin Greenway Inc. (BGGI) is a community-based, volunteer organization with a vision for green, healthy and sustainable communities for all. The BGGI is committed "to create, enhance and conserve an accessible network of nature areas and public pathways that link and support both human and wildlife communities along the Bishop Grandin Boulevard hydro right of way between the Seine and Red Rivers."

The project involves the preservation, enhancement and restoration of natural habitat along a 2 km section of the Bishop Grandin Greenway between St. Mary's Road and the Red River. A "no mow" zone is established in areas where existing vegetation is being encouraged to naturalize; upland native shrubs have been planted to form a buffer with existing residential properties and provide shelter and food to attract additional native wildlife.

Trail Features

- Parking:** Home Depot, 1999 Bishop Grandin Blvd or St. Vital Centre.
- Distance:** ~2.3 km
- Surface Type:** Asphalt surfacing will be complete by summer of 2006
- Suitable For:** Walking, cycling
- Seasons:** Open year around.
- Amenities:** Benches and community garden are planned but not yet installed.
