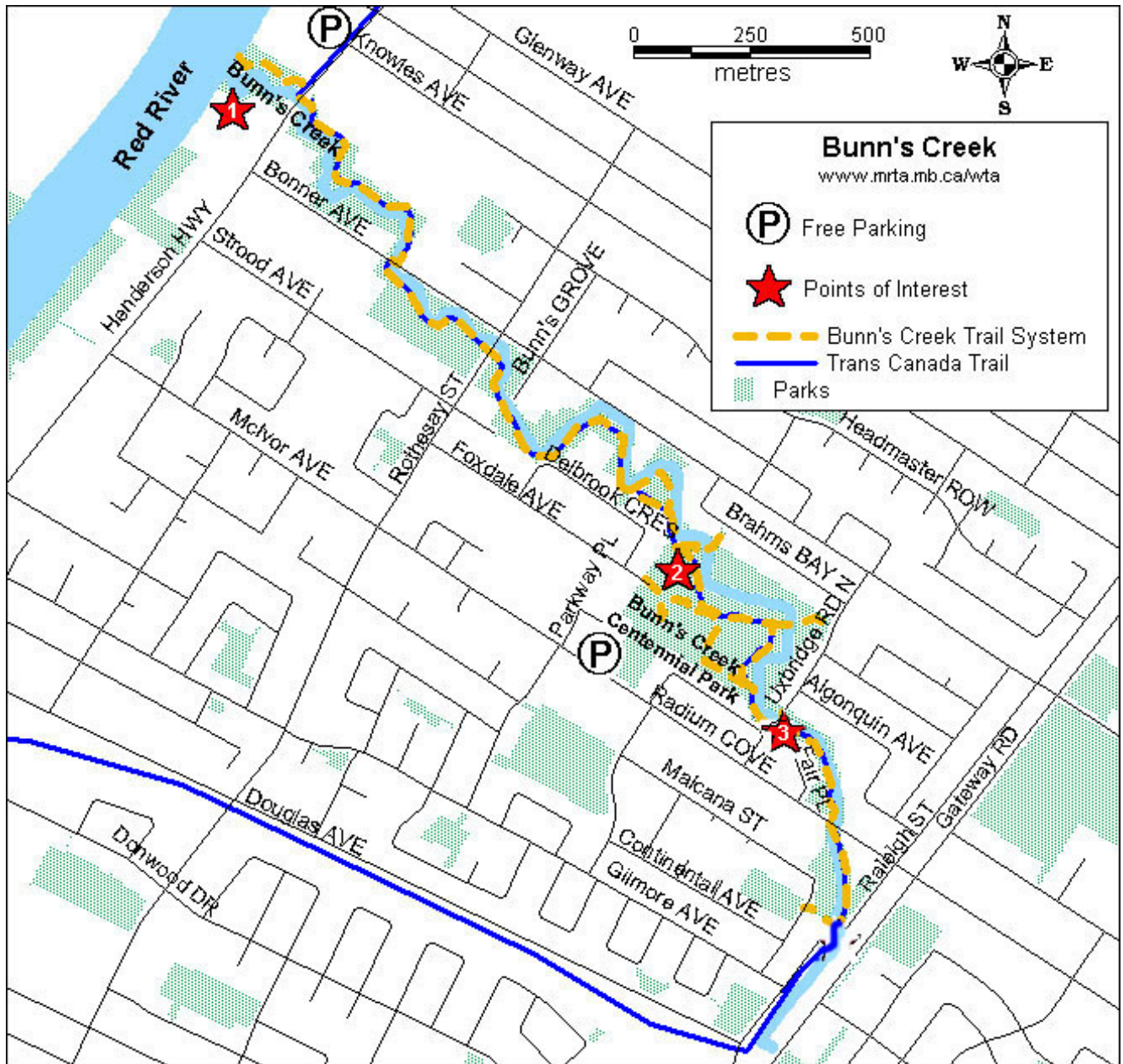


Bunn's Creek

Bunn's Creek Trail meanders through 23 acres of city park space. Bunn's Creek pours into the Red River just south of Knowles avenue and Henderson Hwy. A small park is located at the mouth with a beautiful sitting area shaded by many large stately trees. Many residential homes back onto the trail with magnificent view of flora and fauna. The Bunn's Creek Environmental Stewardship Association (BCESA), founded by local resident, address various issues involving the health and future potential of Bunn's Creek in Winnipeg.

To counter the loss of quality habitat in an urban area, residents developed an action plan entailed restoration work in areas where native vegetation was absent, discontinuing mowing in areas adjacent to river bottom forest so natural regeneration would take place, wrapping older trees established in the river bottom to protect them

from overabundant beavers, and removal of non-native vegetation, specifically purple loosestrife. Project volunteers involve the entire community surrounding Bunn's Creek and hold educational workshops on the significance of the Bunn's Creek watershed.

Bunn's Creek Trail Features

- Parking:** Many residential streets in the area, Bunn's Creek Centennial Park off of McIvor Ave. and a parking lot on the west side of Henderson Hwy.
- Distance:** 3.2 km
- Surface Type:** Compacted gravel
- Suitable For:** Walking, mountain biking.
- Seasons:** Open year around. In early spring, high waters can submerge the trail
- Amenities:** Washrooms available at Bunn's Creek Centennial Park off McIvor Ave.
