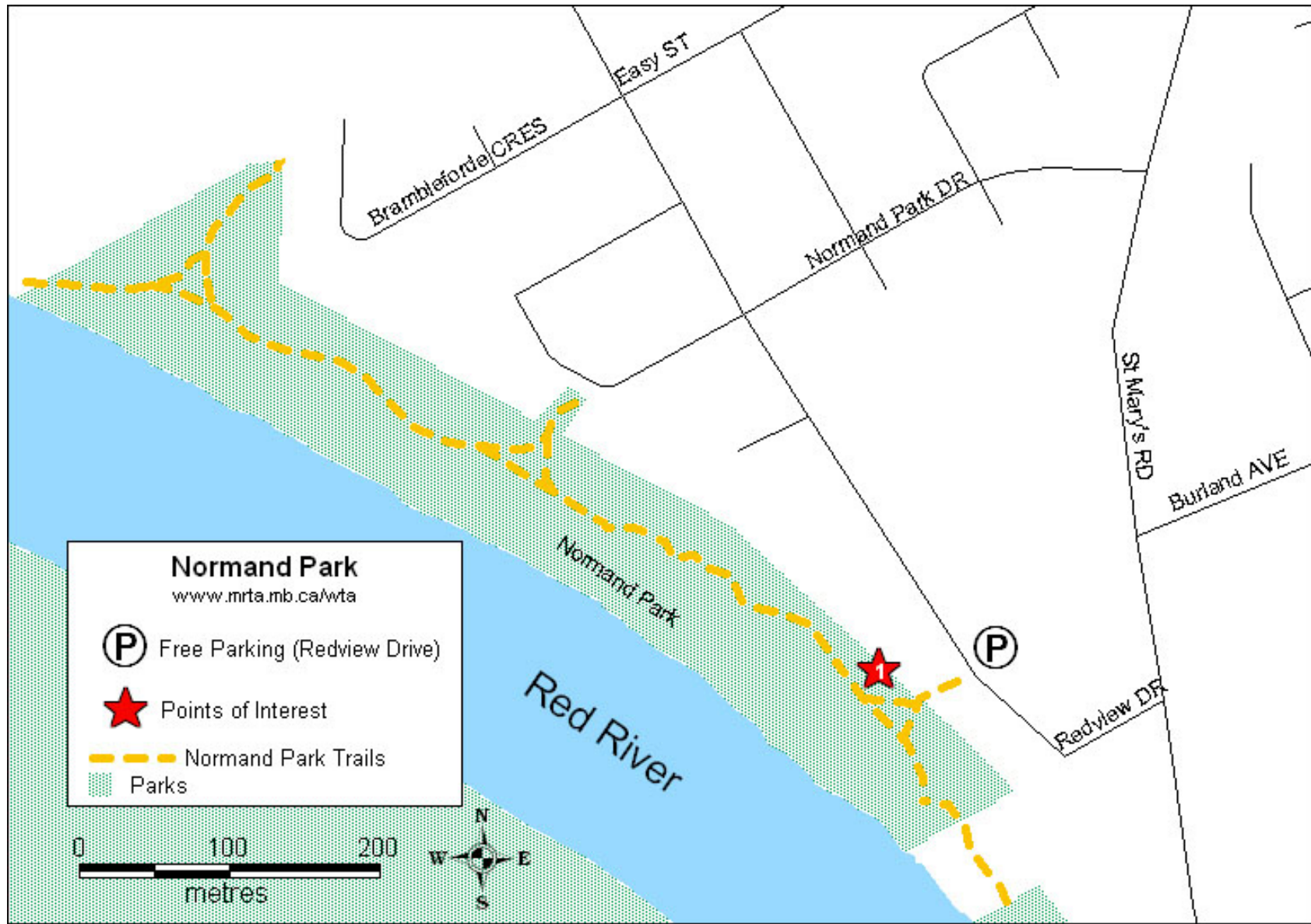

The residential community of Normand Park is nestled into west banks of the Red River. The City of Winnipeg has developed a linear park system along the banks of the Red River which backs onto the residential homes. The park offers spectacular views of the Red River and is home to an extensive variety of birds and animals who live along the riverbank.

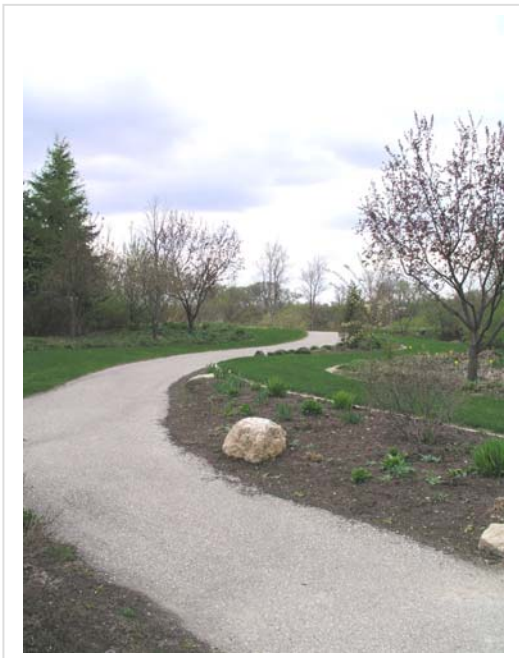
This trail system is one of Winnipeg's well kept secrets.

A childrens playstructure is located at the south end of the park. Access points to the park are located off Redview Dr., Normand Park Dr. and Brambleforde Crescent.

Normand Park Residents Association is working to connect the trail through to Henteleff Park in the near future.

Trail Features

- Parking:** Park along any side street to access the Park. Redview Dr., Normand Park Dr. and Brambleforde Crescent offer access points into the park.
- Distance:** ~1.1 km
- Surface Type:** crushed gravel
- Suitable For:** Walking, cycling
- Seasons:** Open year around.
- Amenities:** Benches and play structure.
