



St. Vital Park has many types of trail located throughout the grounds. Ranging from monkey trails along the river bank - to bark chip trails in the forest - to an asphalt trail surrounding the central duck pond.

St. Vital Park Trail Features

Parking: Multiple parking locations at parking lots and along streets inside park.

Trail Distance ~5 km of trail throughout the park

Surface Type: ranging from dirt, to barkchip to asphalt

Suitable For: Walking, cycling

Seasons: Most trails are open year around.

Amenities: Benches, interpretive signage, picnic areas, washrooms
