The RM of Reynolds has thrown its support behind a project expecting to see the trail program expand the TransCanada Trail to Lake Winnipeg.

The municipality decided to support a request by the Manitoba Trails Association, which has made an application for funding under the Canada-Manitoba Infrastructure program.

Called the Border to Beaches Project, it could see the development of the TransCanada Trail from the Ontario Border to Winnipeg Beach.

The RM of Reynolds decided to support the project because it encourages healthy living, links communities, is education, and supports tourism and commerce. It is also expected to promote social and economic development in local areas.
